

**Form and style of academic paper submissions**

- 1 The title of the paper, the author's name and address, and a biographical note on her/him should be typed on a coversheet which can be detached from the piece. The paper can then be sent anonymously for peer review. The biographical notes should be of no more than 50 words and should include such information as your name, institutional affiliations, academic history and research interest.
- 2 Abstract: An abstract of up to 200 words should be included. It should be labelled 'Abstract' and should be single-spaced on a separate piece of paper.
- 3 Body: All copy should be on A4 white bond paper, on one side of each sheet. Margins should be at least 2cm on all sides. Font to be Times New Roman, size 12, single-spaced. The pages must be numbered. Section headings and sub-headings should be clearly indicated.
- 4 Referencing: All referencing should adhere to the MLA Endnote style. These should be at the end of the text and should be indicated by corresponding numbers placed in the text.
- 5 Images and illustrations: Contributions must include title, where appropriate, captions and source.
- 6 Spelling: Spelling practices should be consistent throughout the article and should follow the Oxford English Dictionary.
- 7 Manuscripts: Manuscripts should be sent to *postamble*, Centre for African Studies, University of Cape Town, Private Bag, Rondebosch, 7701. If an article is accepted for publication, authors **MUST** submit their work on disk in either Wordperfect or MSWord or via Email to the following address: amble@humanities.uct.ac.za

**Submissions of work with a high image content, creative writing, visual essays**

- 1 All work to be submitted in hard copy first.
- 2 Creative writing: Will not be peer reviewed however the editorial committee reserves the right to edit pieces with the author's permission, prior to publication.
- 3 Image format and resolution: All images must be submitted in JPEG (digital) format with a minimum resolution of 300dpi and a maximum resolution of 600dpi.

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
